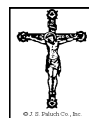

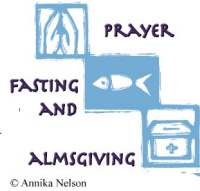
THE PONTIFICAL GOOD FRIDAY COLLECTION APRIL 19, 2019

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence from meats is to be observed by all Catholics 14 years old and older on Good Friday and on all Fridays of Lent.



Fasting is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound by this may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

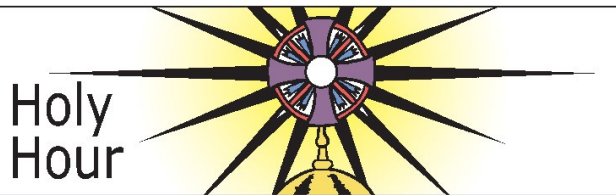

THE STORY OF OUR REDEMPTION

We begin the final week of Lent with familiar readings. This year, we hear the Passion from the Gospel of Luke. The readings for Palm Sunday and the Passion used to be read on successive Sundays. Now they are combined into a single feast, so that we may see the whole sweep of the glory and the suffering played out. Jesus accepts the adulation of the crowd, the foreshadowing of his glory in the Resurrection. He bids farewell to his disciples in his last Passover, and forgives his tormentors as he dies on the cross. Later this week, we enter the Holy Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, when the whole story of our redemption will play out once again.
