

Weekend Masses - Saturdays: 8am and 5.30pm; Sundays: 8am and 10am English; 12pm and 2pm Spanish Confessions - Saturdays 4pm -5pm (Drive through available at the school entrance)

Guidelines:

Those who visit the Church <u>must</u> follow the directives and restrictions imposed by the Governor and Bishop and respect Blessed Sacrament Church guidelines:

The Sunday obligation to attend Mass is still under suspension until revoked by the Bishop. So, do not to worry about missing Sunday Masses, at this time.

Those who visit the church or attend any religious worship such as adoration and Mass must always wear masks (age 10 and over) or other covering of mouth and nose except when receiving Holy Communion during Mass.

All must use a hand sanitizer upon arrival at the Church. Please bring your own hand sanitizer if possible.

Please bring your own disinfectant wipes and clean your area before and after use.

Maintain social distance of 6', no handshake, no holding hands, no hugs, etc.

Holy Communion will be the Body of Christ.

Holy Communion reception only on the hand (without gloves). Communion will not be given on the tongue.

Those who do not receive Holy Communion are asked to, please, stay in their pew and don't come forward for a blessing.

Music will be provided by the Cantor.

No Hymnals or prayer books will be provided. If you wish, bring your own, but take them when you leave the church. Any items left on the pews will be removed and trashed.

Only the Family restroom will be available for use.

Only the Church main doors (that is southside entrance) will be open for entry and exit.

YOU'VE GOT THIS

Put yourself in the disciples' shoes. This is May, the season of graduations, new jobs, new cars, marriages, and so many other transitions as young people strike out on their own. Jesus reminded the disciples, "I have the power, and I've been teaching you for three years. Now you have the power. Go. Make Disciples. Baptize in the name of the Trinity. Teach them what I taught you." Surely the disciples were frightened, and Jesus must have felt both fear and pride. This was the moment that happens in every lifetime.
