## THE FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST SUNDAY, JUNE 23RD

We owe this beautiful feast to a valiant woman who suffered a great deal to establish a feast out of her love for the Eucharist. St. Juliana of Cornillon was a nun in Belgium in the thirteenth century. She served in a hospital for lepers. She became convinced through her prayer that the liturgical year was incomplete because it had no feast for the Eucharist. Her efforts were not welcome, and a supervising priest sought to punish her for promoting a feast that "nobody wanted." He even had her accused of financial mismanagement and banished her from her convent.

Shortly after she was exiled, the bishop approved the feast. It quickly spread through Europe. In those days, people very seldom received Holy Communion, and so the processions through the streets with the eucharistic bread not only led to an awareness of Christ's hunger to be with us, but prepared the way for a deeper desire to receive Christ's Body and Blood in more frequent Communion.

**Our parish feast day celebration begins at 10:30 a.m. with a Eucharistic Procession and Mass. The celebration continues with a parish picnic.**

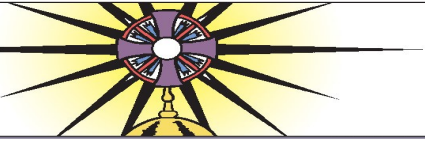

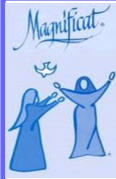

## FIESTA DEL SANTÍSIMO CUERPO Y SANGRE DE CRISTO DOMINGO 23 DE JUNIO

La hermosa fiesta del Santísimo Sacramento se la debemos a una mujer valiente que por su amor a la Eucaristía tuvo que enfrentar muchos sufrimientos y desafíos para establecer esta Fiesta. Santa Juliana de Cornillon era una monja Bélgica del siglo XIII. Sirvió en un hospital para leprosos. Estaba convencida por medio de su oración, que el Año Litúrgico estaba incompleto, porque no tenía una Fiesta para la Eucaristía. Su esfuerzo no fue bien recibido, tuvo que sufrir la dura oposición, incluso el superior de quien dependía su monasterio, buscó el modo de castigarla por promover un banquete que "nadie quería" la acusó de mala administración financiera y la expulsó de su convento.

Poco después de su exilio, el obispo aprobó la fiesta. Se extendió rápidamente por Europa. En aquellos días, la gente rara vez recibía la Sagrada Comunión, y con las procesiones por las calles con el Pan Eucarístico, no solo ayudo a despertar la conciencia del hambre que Cristo tiene por estar con nosotros, sino que preparo el camino para un deseo más profundo de recibir con más frecuencia el Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, en la Sagrada Comunión.

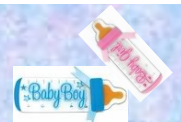
