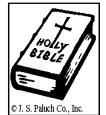
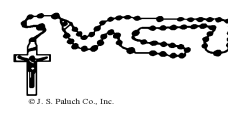

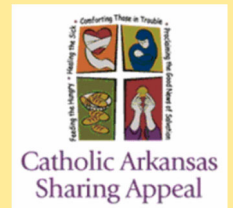


CATHOLIC ARKANSAS SHARING APPEAL

CASA funds are used for all the offices that provide services that exceed what most parishes are able to provide on the local level: Vocations, Catholic Charities, our Faith Formation programs, Catholic Schools, Hispanic Ministry, our deacon formation program, our Tribunal, our Pro-Life activities, and many others. \$75,000 of CASA money is used to support our seminarians. We ordained 18 new priests in the last 3 year. We presently have around 60 men from all around the state in formation to become permanent deacons- **3 are from Blessed Sacrament.**

In our diocese we are asked to give 1% of your gross income to CASA. Our parish goal for 2019 is: \$38,409.05; to date \$13,764.33 has been donated and with \$5,245 in outstanding pledges.
