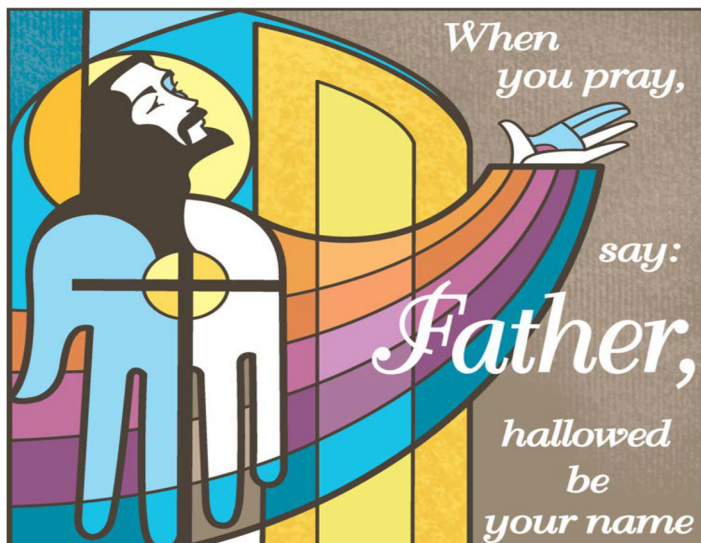

NELLORE, INDIA

The Diocese of Nellore is a mission diocese that depends upon external support. The majority of the Catholics are poor laborers in the farms of the landlords. They live by daily wages. The parishes can't afford their own maintenance. The utilities, constructions, and almost everything that parishes need, including the priests' salaries are met by the diocese. Out of 170 about 40 priests are working in various parishes of the United States solely with the intention of being supportive to their home diocese. Including Fr. Francis and I, there are 13 priests currently working in Arkansas. Every month each of us sends a major portion of our salaries to the diocese. Bishop Taylor is kind to allow us to appeal a second collection in the parishes we are serving once every year. Your contributions will help in maintaining the diocese and specifically in the following areas:

- 3 leper colonies
- 5 homes for physically and mentally challenged and hearing impaired children
- 20 orphanages and/or boarding homes in which free food and free accommodation and free education is offered without which many of these kids would not go to school.
- Salaries for 130 Priests;
- Education of 20 Seminarians; etc.

Baby Boxes**



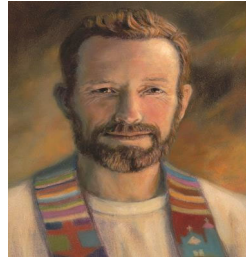

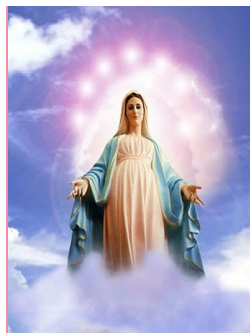
La diócesis de Nellore es una diócesis misionera y depende del apoyo externo. Muchos de los católicos son trabajadores pobres que trabajan en las granjas de los dueños de la tierra y viven de su salario diario. La mayoría de las parroquias NO se consideran autosuficientes desde el punto de vista financiero. Los servicios públicos, las construcciones y casi todo lo que necesitan las parroquias, incluyendo los salarios de los sacerdotes, son financiados por la diócesis. Somos 170 sacerdotes, y 40 de nosotros estamos aquí en Estados Unidos, uno de los objetivos es apoyar a nuestra diócesis local. El padre Francis, yo, y otros 13 sacerdotes más estamos sirviendo actualmente en Arkansas. Nosotros enviamos la mayoría de nuestro salario cada mes. El Obispo Taylor amablemente nos ha permitido tener una colecta especial cada año para el beneficio de los programas pastorales y sociales de la diócesis. Sus contribuciones ayudan a mantener específicamente las siguientes fundaciones:

3 colonias de personas con lepra  
5 hogares para niños con discapacidades mentales, físicas y con problemas de audición  
20 orfanatorios/o pensiones donde se ofrece comida, alojamiento y educación gratuita, sin los cuales muchos de estos niños no irían a la escuela  
Salarios para 130 sacerdotes  
Educación de 20 seminaristas y mucho más.
